1.1 When and where will the event take place?

1.8. Will there be an awareness team?

Yes, there will be an awareness team. The members of the team will introduce themselves to the guests on the event. The awareness team is available as a point of contact to provide support with concerns related to discrimination and the violation of personal boundaries.

2. Participation

2.1 What costs are covered by Stiftung Mercator and what do I need to pay for myself?

Stiftung Mercator covers the following costs for participation:

- Catering during the Mercator Globe Forum.
- Hotel accommodation (and breakfast upon request) for the relevant event days.
- Maximum €120 for second class train travel expenses, with receipt.
- Flight Travel expenses. According to our travel policy, flight reimbursement is allowed only if the train journey exceeds 6 hours. Only economy class or its equivalent will be covered.
- No participation fee will be charged.

Participants must cover the following costs themselves:

- Train travel expenses exceeding €120.
- Additional costs incurred if the stay is extended (additional overnight stays etc.).
- All costs not listed above, e.g., meals outside of event hours.

2.2 Cancellation

Do I need to inform the event team if I cannot attend but have already received a confirmation of my registration?

Yes, absolutely! Please inform us as early as possible at <u>MercatorGlobeForum@n-ec.de</u> if you are unable to attend. We also kindly ask you to inform us of any cancellations, in order to give other participants the opportunity to attend and to support the reduction of our carbon footprint. In the event of cancellation at short notice (by March 3, 2025) or a no-show without prior notice, the participant must bear the costs incurred by us.

Confirmed participants will receive detailed information about travel cost reimbursement in due time, after their confirmation.

3.5 Can I extend my stay in Essen / arrive earlier or depart later?

You are free to do so. However, you must bear the costs for extending your stay yourself.
